Commercial Waste Recycling Costs

In most cases we have to charge businesses for collecting their waste for recycling. The value of the materials tends to be quite low, collection costs are high and there are no subsidies available for recycling commercial waste (the recycling of household waste attracts 'Recycling Credit' payments).

You'll find our rates are extremely competitive though and they are generally cheaper than normal waste collection charges (for the equivalent amount of waste).

Care for the Environment

As required under the Environmental Protection Act 1990, we comply with the **Duty of Care**, by taking all reasonable steps to keep waste safe and to ensure it is properly managed. As part of this obligation, we supply annual **Waste Transfer Notes** to all our customers, detailing the type of waste collected for recycling, the producer of the waste and the carrier.

Eden Community Recycling - Who are we?

We are a **Not-for-Profit** recycling company that grew out of a voluntary group; Eden Charity Recycling.

From one collection point in Penrith's fire station car park in 1981, we have grown to have our own depot and recycling centres across Eden.

All proceeds from our recycling activities go into improving our facilities and services and towards **local community fundraising**.

During the 2004-05 financial year, we were able to hand over a total of **£8,000** to schools and community groups in Eden in return for their recycling efforts.

We still rely on our band of willing volunteers but we now have five employed staff to enable us to provide a **reliable and professional** service.

We Recycle:

Polystyrene

We have recently set up a scheme for recycling expanded polystyrene, the first of its kind in Cumbria. If you have clean polystyrene to get rid of, you can deliver it to our depot in Penrith for recycling.

Small pieces of polystyrene must be securely bagged.

Paper and Card

We accept all types and grades of paper and cardboard, mixed (no need for sorting). Basically if it tears, we can recycle it.

We can take:

- ✓ Cardboard & lightweight card
- ✓ Computer print-outs
- ✓ Directories and Yellow Pages
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Junk Mail
- ✓ Magazines
- ✓ Newspapers
- ✓ Office paper

You can choose from the following collection methods for your paper and card:

- We can provide a large wheeled container (as shown on the front of this leaflet) at £5 per week
- You can deliver any amount of paper & card to our depot at Penrith Industrial Estate for £10 per month
- Or, deliver any amount of paper & card to the board mill at Little Salkeld, free of charge!

Plastics
